

WRITTEN ARRANGEMENTS

Yeshiva Ohr Elchonon Chabad offers its students a select number of educational opportunities at specific institutions in Israel and abroad. Courses offered are similar in content and style to those offered at Yeshiva Ohr Elchonon Chabad. This gives students of Yeshiva Ohr Elchonon Chabad the opportunity to broaden their horizons by studying and mingling with students of other cultures in the natural surroundings of those students. These arrangements are approved by our accrediting agency, AARTS.

Study abroad is limited to 30 credits and is only available to students who enroll for the purpose of obtaining a Bachelor of Rabbinical Studies Degree. Study abroad students must be enrolled for at least one semester at the host school, Yeshiva Ohr Elchonon Chabad, prior to attending the institution abroad.

The method of delivery for the portion of the educational program offered at the Study Abroad Institutions specified below is in person.
